

Land Forces 2026

Book a meeting and go in the draw to win a \$1000 workplace wellbeing activation.

Terms and Conditions

1. Promoter

The promoter is Defence Health Limited ABN 80 008 629 481 of Level 7, 380 St Kilda Road, Melbourne VIC 3004 ("Defence Health" or "Promoter").

2. Competition Period

The competition opens at 9:00am AWST on Tuesday 6th October 2026 and close AWST on Wednesday 21st October 2026 at 3:00pm AWST being the close of the Land Forces 2026 International Land Defence Exposition held in Perth, Western Australia ("Competition Period").

Entries received outside the Competition Period will not be accepted.

3. Eligibility

Entry is open only to individuals that are entering on behalf of their organisation who:

- are aged 18 years or over;
- attend Land Forces 2026;
- During Land Forces 2026, book in a meeting with Defence Health Partnership Manager linked to Land Forces promotion;
- are employed by, represent, or are authorised to act on behalf of an organization that has employees who are eligible to take out private health insurance with Defence Health, including because:
 - is a Defence-related government agency or department;
- provide all requested entry information by completing the entry form supplied by Defence Health; and
- Consenting to Defence Health contacting them regarding partnership opportunities.

The following persons are not eligible to enter:

- current Defence Health employees;
- contractors that are directly involved in administering this Competition;

- immediate family members of Defence Health employees involved in administering the Competition.

4. How to Enter

To enter the competition, an eligible entrant must during the Competition Period:

2. Complete the competition entry form by scanning the QR code or completing the electronic form provided.
3. Book a meeting with Defence Health Partnership Manager.

5. Consent to Defence Health collecting and using the information in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.

Entry is free.

A maximum of one (1) entry per individual is permitted.

Multiple individuals from the same organisation may enter provided each person submits a separate entry and meets the eligibility criteria.

Incomplete, illegible, misleading or fraudulent entries may be deemed invalid at the Promoter's discretion.

5. Prize

There will be one (1) winning organisation. If multiple eligible representatives of the same organisation enter the promotion, each eligible representative may submit one entry. If a winning entry is drawn, the prize will be awarded to that entrant's organisation.

The winning organisation may choose one of the following workforce wellbeing activations valued at up to AUD \$1,000 (including GST):

Option A: Workplace Wellbeing Webinar

7. Prize Draw

The winner will be selected through a randomised electronic draw from all eligible entries received during the Competition Period.

A record of the draw process will be retained by Defence Health for audit purposes.

8. Winner Notification and redraw

The winner will be contacted by email and/or telephone within two (2) business days of the draw.

Defence Health will make reasonable attempts to contact the winner including:

- initial notification;
- follow-up contact;
- reminder communications where required.

If the winner cannot be contacted or does not respond within fourteen (14) days of the first initial notification attempt, Defence Health will conduct a redraw using the same notification process until a winner is contacted.

If the prize remains unclaimed 14 days after the first notification attempt, a redraw will occur at Defence Health's Melbourne office at 10.00am AEDT on [date]. The redraw winner will be notified within two business days of the redraw by email and telephone.

- any variation, postponement, suspension or cancellation of the Competition or any prize;
